



SPHS Football Booster Club
Monday, July 13, 2009

1. Opening - The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed. Julie Hopp made a motion to accept and Sonia Felisano seconded them.
2. Coaches Report – Coach Chessher spoke about the spring games. All the teams did very well. Coach Chessher also spoke about the 7 on 7 team. They went 8-0 in the state games. He stated that SPHS has good talent, the boys played hard, had really good endurance; especially in the heat that they had to play in. The boys represented SPHS very well; they are competitive – all wanted to play. The kids have the knowledge that they can play anyone in the state; they were not intimidated at all! Coach Brett Percefull has been hired to coach the incoming freshman that will be going to Cedar Ridge H.S. This group of boys will make up the Freshman White Team at SPHS. Coach Percival moves to SPHS from C.D. Fulkes M.S. Aug. 10th football practice will start with scrimmages on Aug. 20th. Coach Vasek had back surgery and will be returning for the fall season. Coach Judd Thrash (from Rockwall ISD) has also been hired.
3. Financial Report – Current balance is \$16,365.55 Julie Hopp made a motion to approve the financial report and Shari Ramming seconded.
4. Old/New Business –
 - a.) RRISD has approved the booster club to sell Bush's Iced Tea at the football games. Bush's donates all the Tea, ice, 32 oz cups. It was discussed about maybe selling Bush's Tender Rolls as well.
 - b.) The band and cheerleaders will be at the "Palace" for the Aug. 20th scrimmages. It was discussed to sell water and tea at the scrimmage.
 - c.) Asking for ideas, slogans, designs for t-shirts
 - d.) Meet the Tiger will be Friday, Sept. 18th. It was suggested that Bush's Ice Tea be sold at MTT. Gene Garza made a motion to accept and Susan Morello seconded. The price to be determined.
 - e.) It was noted that Coach Chessher is our school sponsor.
 - f.) Flyers regarding the upcoming parent meeting on Monday, Aug. 10th will be distributed to all incoming freshman at their freshman football camp. Susan Morello has volunteered to pass these out to the freshman boys. Thank you Susan!
 - g.) All members that volunteer to chair a committee will have their picture put into the program.
 - h.) We will need volunteers to help set up tables for the Aug. 10 parent meeting. At the meeting we will have signups for banquets, programs, selling of Tea, Coaches lunches, selling of merchandise, Tunnel Crew, etc.
 - i.) Can we sell Kettle Korn? Does anyone know who makes it?

- j.) Gene Garza will be in charge of the Tunnel Crew, Kristi Anderlohr will chair the Coaches lunches. Looking for “chairs” to head up many other happenings!
 - k.) It was suggested that we sell Tumblers as a fundraiser. Susan Morello is looking into prices.
 - l.) It will be discussed and/or voted to have the dollar figure taken out of our bylaws at the Aug. 3rd meeting. As well as the word “bonded” out. Danny suggested that he not sign checks but that he audits every check.
 - m.) It was noted that we paid Coach Chessher the money that he had requested.
 - n.) Gary Alvarez had us listen to audio sounds to be synchronized during the football games. He stated that he would start it up for the first couple of games but would then need someone to take over. Paul Hopp volunteered to do this if the “sound effects” are approved. Concerns are that the band, cheerleaders and Jim McKay may have some issues (not sure if this is the correct word to use!) Shari Ramming is going to get in contact with Jim, Rose Trevathon will contact the band and cheerleaders so that they can come to the next meeting to listen to and put their input into the idea of the sound effects. Paul Hopp made a motion to accept and Julie Hopp seconded.
 - o.) Christine Peterson was contacted by David Behr (PrepLive) – on line High School; he would like a contact from SPHS to text, email or call him with scores throughout the game. It was noted that our web site is updated regularly and that he can go directly to it for updates.
5. Adjourn – a motion to adjourn was made by Paul Hopp and was seconded by Kevin Finch.
