1. Opening - The meeting was called to order by Rose Trevathan
2. Coach Chessher –
 - No longer need the trophy cases
 - Cleats for next year will be around \$4,200
 - Jersey's: the district to purchase 2 sets; w/the activity fund will purchase a 3rd.
 - Weight room – finished end of May – first week of June. Transfer old weights to new one.
 - 4,000 sq ft. weight room
 - What can Nautilus give us? It needs to be “good stuff” – updated weights not old ones. Good equipment would be \$80,000/\$65,000 get done in 2-3 years.
 - Numbers: 320 last year; 240 this year. Next year should be pretty good, following year we'll take a hit.
 - Will play 2 games from team out of the country; University Nuevo Leon on Aug. 26th; they would like to be fed What a Burger. District may pay but it's questionable. Can the booster buy this food for the opposing team?

 - \$17,900 in account: Minus the bills outstanding, which will leave roughly \$4,000 in account.
 - \$4,400 goes to scholarships
 - Last year we raised \$20,000 from sponsors – which was huge.
 - Consider an auction for a fundraiser, get started in the summer on fundraising. A carnival? Charge for booths? May not have Meet the Tigers this fall.
