1. Opening- Rose Garza
2. Coaches Report- Coach Chessher
  - Rated # 6 in the state
  - Spring Game: over all felt good, defense dominated the game, looking for kickers,
  - 7-on-7 better this weekend than last weekend, 3-0 but lost to Kline Forest in the semifinal overtime 34-33; did not qualify for A&M, 5 to 2 in two tournaments. Only one injury but athlete doing good now.
  - Defense is doing good; offense will take awhile depending on the adjustments
  - Summer Speed & Agility – 305 participants (55-60 females): varsity at 8:30 am, JV at 9:30 am, and Freshman at 10:30 am
  - Coaching staff changes: Scott Stuart – Defense Coordinator, Charles Taylor – Offense Coordinator from LBJ, and Oscar Lujan – Defense Coordinator from Lamar Consolidated.
  - First camp 3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade had a slow start but kids are doing a great job.
  - Incoming cost that Chessher is requesting: \$2,500 to finish paying weights now, \$4,500 for shoes by July, and \$2,500 for food by Sept/Oct (we will feed two teams from Mexico)
  - Redistricting will occur Feb 2012
  - Scrimmage is set for Aug 19<sup>th</sup> against A&M Consolidated at Reeves Stadium
  - May have 3 freshman teams next year, looking at between 118 and 130 athletes; Varsity 60 athletes (6 non-seniors)
  - Coaches bio for the website needed, Chessher will get with coaches
