Scholarship Information



Traditionally the Stony Point Football Booster Club has given a scholarship to graduating seniors using the proceeds for “Pass the Helmet”. Each athlete applying for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Parents must belong to SPHS Football Booster Club and be a member in good standing for each year that their athlete is a member of the football team, starting with the 2008/2009 school year.
2. Each year parents must complete 10 hours of volunteer service to the team.

1 st year	10 total hours
2 nd year	10 total hours
3 rd year	10 total hours
4 th year	10 total hours

The majority of this service needs to be logged during the football season.

3. The athlete must be a graduating senior the year that they apply.
4. The athlete must be attending a university or school of higher education the following year.
5. The athlete must provide proof of enrollment at a university or school of higher education.

Qualifications Requirements:

Player or parent must be a dues paying member of the Stony Point Football Booster Club on **October 7, 2011**; the family of the player must provide at least 10 hours of volunteer service to the booster club during this school year; the player must be a graduating senior who was on the roster for the entire 2011 Football season; and the player must be attending a university or school of higher education by the Fall Semester of “2011”; and provide proof of their post – graduation enrollment by September 1, 2012.

Process:

All scholarship awards funded through Round Rock ISD affiliated organizations must be administered through the business office for the local high school. In our case, the funding must be administered through the business office, aka bookkeeping at Stony Point High School.

Accordingly, the Stony Point Football Booster Club will transfer the scholarship award proceeds for your son’s award to the business office at Stony Point High School. The Football Booster Club will provide the business office your son’s name, address and amount of the scholarship award. Under the guidelines, you will then provide proof of enrollment to the business office. The business office will then send the scholarship award to the college or university of your son’s choice. The business office is located in room A-137. Phone number 428-7034.

In the case of unusual circumstances, which preclude the player's family from meeting the volunteer requirement, Coach Chessher will have the authority to waive this requirements. Such a waiver will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
